

Cigna Medical Changes Effective 5/12/23

Ending the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency

The purpose of this document is to provide an overview of the changes made to the Cigna medical plans as a result of the ending of the public health emergency (PHE). All changes go into effect on 5/12/23.

	During PHE – before 5/11/23	Post PHE – starting 5/12/23
PCR Testing	Covered at 100%	Covered at the normal medical plan cost share under the lab benefit when medically necessary
OTC Rapid Tests	Coverage of 8 OTC COVID-19 tests per month without a prescription, with a \$0 member cost share	No longer covered under the pharmacy plan
	Covered at 100% through the pharmacy benefit	Rapid tests are eligible for medical reimbursement under health savings accounts (HSA) and flexible spending accounts (FSA)
Vaccinations	Covered in-network and out-of-network at 100%,	In-network vaccines are 100% covered as a preventive health service
		Out-of-network vaccines covered at the normal cost share
Treatment	Covered at the normal medical plan cost share	No change – continued coverage at the normal medical cost share
Antivirals and Therapeutics	Covered at the normal medical plan cost share	No change – continued coverage at the normal medical cost share
